Longley Park, Sheffield

Location of Venue

Longley Park is 3 miles to the north of Sheffield city centre, in an area just north of Northern General Hospital. It is bounded by Crowder Road to the south west, Longley Lane and Barnsley Road (A6135) to the south east and Elm Lane to the north.

How to Get There

From Sheffield city centre several buses visit the park. The nearest railway station is Chapeltown and frequent buses go from there with stops very close to the park. There are entrances on all sides of the park.

The postcode for Longley Sixth Form College, at the far east corner of the park is S5 2QA

Parking

There is one small car park, off Crowder Road. This will be for the use of officials and marshalls, which means that all parking is on surrounding streets. Please park considerately and be aware of the access needs of local residents.

Refreshments

There are no refreshment facilities in the park.

Toilets

There will be 4 portable toilets in the small car park off Crowder Road.

About the courses

The terrain is mostly cut parkland grass, but there will be one or two sections where the grass is longer and although the start field is flat, the terrain is generally undulating with with one fairly steep hill. There will be one or two path crossings on each lap, but the paths are not wide. After rain, some sections of the course can be muddy.

Other Important Information

Registration for the final fixture has been extended to Thursday 19th January. If you have bought a number for the final fixture and can not make the rearranged fixture then you are entitled to a refund from the running club but please ensure that Judith knows if refunds have been given.

The fixture is run with senior males first through to U11 girls last. Championship medals will be given out to U17 runners and under on the day. All other medals will be distributed to clubs as soon as results are verified.

You must wear your club vest for racing and have the correct number pinned to the front. If you do not have these then you will be disqualified from the race and not appear in the results

You must not wear headphones or devices that allow you to listen to music as you need to be able to hear the instructions of marshals and other users of the area

If a junior drops out of the race then they nee	ed to report to the finish area to inform officials
